

WEEK 9: Birds and Bears

■ Using the Right Word, Numbers, Comma (Nonrestrictive Phrases and Clauses)

Polar bears can run about thirty-five miles per hour which is as fast as lions can run.

■ Adjective (Comparative/Superlative), Subject-Verb Agreement, Semicolon

The most largest bird is the ostrich it weigh as much as 300 pounds.

■ Apostrophe, Double Subject, Pronoun-Antecedent Agreement, Numbers

Ostriches they cant fly, but it can run as fast as forty miles per hour.

■ Parentheses, Numbers

The bee hummingbird about 2 inches long builds a nest the size of half a walnut shell.

■ Numbers, Colon or Dash, End Punctuation

A bird called the arctic tern migrates from the North Pole to the South Pole and back again each year about twenty-two thousand miles round-trip
